


Status Report Stakeholder Outreach on Alternative Submittal





General Overview

- 6 separate meetings & 1 Workshop
 - Sloughhouse RCD, Omochumne-Hartnell WD, Cosumnes Coalition, Farm Bureau, Elk Grove WD/Florin RCD, Sheldon residents
- Important opportunity to better understand Alternative Submittal and concerns
- Mixed reactions to Alternative Submittal approach to SGMA compliance
- <u>Initial</u> brainstorming on possible remedies



Comments of Concern

- De facto baseline
- Governance challenges
- Environmental concerns
- Undesirable results
- Lacks aggressive proactive focus

Comments of Support

- Builds on existing work
- Fosters collaboration
- Provides for dialogue:
 Cosumnes Sub-Basin
- Potential standard of good stewardship

Common threads:

Look-back structure feels constraining; limits looking forward Alternative Submittal process has been very fast



De facto Baseline

- Works against desired basin boundary change
- Has implications on the sustainable yield
- Does not address recharge accounting

Governance Challenges

- Jurisdictional overlap: entities already filed as GSAs
- Inadequate local representation & fear of top-down regulations
- Entities split across sub-basins



Environmental Concerns

- Limits ability to
 - Address flow for the Cosumnes River (for fall run Chinook)
 - Protect groundwater-dependent ecosystems
- This is not "Nirvana"

Undesirable Results

- Falling groundwater levels
- Disconnect with Cosumnes River likely expanding (depth and length)



Lacks Proactive Focus

- Reliance on 2006 GMP limits scope for future
- Sidesteps SGMA's more comprehensive approach
- Envision a more proactive SCGA Board
 - In support of groundwater management
 - Involvement / leadership in river restoration projects



Other Comments & Questions


- Process moving too fast
- Inadequate outreach or time to consider
- Past and ongoing trust issues not resolved
- Has the potential to constrain future land use
- Process questions (CEQA, DWR review timeline, GSA track, Board of Supervisors check-in, etc.)
- Broad range of clarifying questions

Where Go From Here?

- Varied reactions
 - Need to think about it more
 - Pursue Alternative Submittal but address concerns
 - Withdraw Alternative Submittal; pursue GSP
- Ideas: Address concerns in Alternative Submittal
 - Alternative Submittal text revisions
 - Remind ourselves: 2006 GMP includes broad range of actions
- Ideas: Address concerns OUTSIDE of Alt. Submittal
 - Joint commitments to cross-basin coordination agreements
 - Work towards mutual resolution of GSA overlaps
 - Consideration of needed governance changes
 - Support Cosumnes River pre-wetting and recharge
 - A more proactive SCGA
 - Improved outreach in all processes going forward
